 Ever wondered what you can do about the inhumane way in which livestock are being transported and slaughtered?

The USPCA is your answer.

A USPCA office investigates reports of mistreatment of animals and attempts to report stray animals.
 The USPCA conducts pet distribution and spay/neuter clinics that allow communities to act of change.
 The USPCA offers humane education programs to schools.
 The USPCA has been involved with promoting adoption / buying of abandoned or neglected dogs and cats.
 The USPCA has been working with both local and national governments, law enforcement and the agricultural industry to establish improved standards and guidelines for the humane transport and slaughter of livestock as well as its enforcement.
 The USPCA has been successful in setting up Animal Check Points (ACPs) in transport stations to monitor the humane transport of livestock from one county to the city stations.
 The USPCA conducts free road clinics offering spay/neuter, deworming and treatment of conditions of livestock and other animals.
 The USPCA maintains a pet loss list and also provides free clinics, free humane education in communities and schools.
