The USPCA has been successful in setting up Animal Check Points (ACP) in various states to monitor the humane transport of livestock from one county to the next.
The USPCA conducts free road shows offering spay/neuter services, deworming and treatment of conditions of livestock and other animals.
The USPCA maintains a pet loss helpline and provides free advice, free humane education in communities and schools.
